






Forbes School of Business and Technology is proud to offer students and faculty with unlimited access to Forbes.com online articles. Some courses identify Forbes.com articles as required reading.


STEPS TO CREATE YOUR FORBES.COM ACCOUNT

1. Disable pop-up blockers in your browser settings, as applicable.
2. Log out of Forbes.com, if you are already logged in under another account.
3. **IMPORTANT!** Use this URL to log in: <http://account.forbes.com/sign-in?type=new>

4. Click on the pop-up, as shown in Figure 4.
5. Complete the account registration (pop-up) form, **using the UAGC email address provided by the University**, as shown in Figure 5.
6. If you have already created a Forbes.com account with your UAGC email address, click “Sign in”, instead. As needed, click the “I Forgot My Password” link, as shown in Figure 6.



7. Once you have completed this process, either by creating a new account or signing in, you will see an on-screen confirmation of your unlimited access to Forbes.com articles, as shown in Figure 7.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. How long will I have access to my Forbes.com online article subscription?** Your Forbes.com unlimited article access will expire upon completion of your FSBT studies or UAGC employment.
- 2. I am not getting a pop-up, what should I do?** Please make sure your pop-up blocker is disabled.
- 3. I cannot access this website via Internet Explorer.** Use another browser such as Mozilla or Google Chrome. If the website, is still not accessible, it is recommended to clear your browser history and clear your cache.
- 4. What will I use this subscription for?** Some courses list Forbes articles as required resources. Required resources are needed to complete specific tasks in each course.
- 5. What email address do I use to access this subscription?** Students, Full Time Faculty, and Associate Faculty must use their UAGC email address to have unlimited access to Forbes.com articles:
